

## Hub Style Insulated Ice Shelter Instructions


### Set-up

#### Step 1.

Remove the ice shelter from the carry bag along with the ice anchors. Remove the cinch strap from around the shelter and store in the carry bag for easy locating when packing up.




#### Step 2.

Lay the ice shelter flat on the ice or ground. Spread the shelter out as much as possible. Make sure the material is not twisted and none of the pole ends are entangled or overlapping. **Do not** force shelter when unfolding.



#### Step 3.

Grasp the loop attached to the eyelet at the center of one of the walls. Pull outward until the wall pops open. **Note:** In windy conditions it will be necessary to anchor the wall and two corners down with the ice anchors and straps. Proceed around the shelter and pull out each wall so it pops into place. Anchor as necessary for the conditions. Once all of the walls are pulled into position the roof may be pushed upward from within.



Anchor as required for the conditions.

#### Step 4.

The Pro Lodge with the full door has extra support poles that may be secured along the sides and the top of door if so desired and can be used in extreme conditions.


## Take Down

#### Step 1.

Remove the ice anchors and anchor strap from one wall. Store the anchors in the provided pouch and the strap in the sewn-on pocket on the side wall. Depending on the wind conditions all of the anchors and anchor straps may be removed and stored away.


#### Step 2.

Push in on the center hub of the side wall until it collapses inward. Proceed around the shelter, removing the ice anchors and anchor straps as necessary, and collapse each wall inward. The shelter will collapse onto the ice or ground on its own. Then push inward on the roof hub until it collapses as well.



#### Step 3.

The shelter will now be back in its flat stage. Gather all of the corners of the shelter and fold them together. All of the poles should be aligned and the hubs should be towards one end. Do not force the poles into position. Move the poles as necessary to prevent entanglement.



#### Step 4.

Using the provided cinch strap, loop it around the shelter and pull it tight. Slide the shelter into the carry bag with the hubs towards the plastic liner inside the bag. Place the ice anchor pouch inside the bag as well.
