


4&6 Sided Insulated Hub Style-Ice Shelter

↑ SET-UP


STEP 1:

Remove ice shelter from backpack carry bag. Remove the tie strap from around the shelter.



STEP 2:


Lay the ice shelter flat on the ground. Make sure there is no twisted material or overlapping ends on any of the poles. DO NOT force shelter when unfolding. Watch for entanglement of poles.



STEP 3:


Grasp the webbing loop attached to the eyelet located in the center of the roof and pull outward until the roof section pops open.

Note: For the 6 sided Resort Hub pop all of the sides out first and then go inside and pop the roof up.




STEP 4:

Grasp the webbing loop attached to the eyelet located at the center of one of the walls and pull outward so that the wall pops open.



STEP 5:

Walk around the shelter and pop out each wall by pulling on the center loop. **Note:** Care should be taken during windy conditions when setting up. It may be necessary to attach an ice anchor and rope to secure the tent before popping out all of the sides.




STEP 6:

The shelter should now be standing up. You may now proceed by anchoring the shelter to the ice using the provided ice anchors and rope.

↓ TAKE-DOWN


STEP 1:

Remove all ropes and ice anchors and store them in the provided pouch. Rope may be stored in the pouch sewn onto the tent below the center eyelet.



STEP 2:

Using your hand, push the center hub in on each of the walls until they collapse inward. Shelter will fall to the ice on its own. Push in the roof hub until it collapses as well.



STEP 3:

The shelter will be back in its flat Stage, just as it was when it was unfolded out of the backpack. Gather all corners of the shelter and fold together. Do not force the shelter when folding. Watch for entanglement of poles.

STEP 4:

Take provided tie strap and wrap around folded shelter to allow for easier insertion into carry bag. Place folded shelter back into the carry bag with the hubs toward the bottom end of bag. Place the pouch with the ice anchors and extra ropes into backpack as well.
